

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To participate in Meet Catalunya organized by the Catalan Tourist Board we kindly ask you to read this document carefully and the registration implies acceptance of these terms and conditions:

1. The Catalan Tourist Board accepts no liability in case of illness, accident or other circumstances where travel insurance may be required. Therefore it is strongly advised that all participants purchase medical and travel insurance before depart from their home country.
2. The Catalan Tourist Board cannot assume responsibility for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense arising out of injury, accident or death, damage or frustration, whether physical or mental, resulting from, but not limited to:
 - Mechanical breakdowns, governmental actions, strike, war, lockouts, weather, acts of god, acts of terrorism or other factors beyond our control.
 - Acts of vandalism, air, land or sea piracy, burglaries, accidents, fires, injuries, assaults or any physical harm to your property and/or person.
 - Your failure to follow instructions including passports and visas.
3. The participation will include: transportation and transfers, accommodation, fam trips, meals, a workshop and other complementary activities detailed in the programme.
4. The participation requires a deposit cost of 100 €, which must be paid by credit card during the registration process. The payment will be returned to the participants attending the Meet Catalunya, once the event is over.
5. All participants acknowledge that they will follow the programme defined by the ACT and participate in the scheduled activities. The participants must also attend all appointments requested by Catalan companies, and vice versa.
6. All participants in the Meet Catalunya will permit the use of their image rights to the ACT and will give their authorisation to include their image in photos, videos, and other promotional audio-visual materials of the event. The ACT may use this material for promotional or commercial purposes.
7. The ACT reserves the right to alter or cancel the event if necessary. If this were the case, the registered companies would be notified in advance.
