## Discover the bellowing in the Cijara\_

Cijara Regional Hunting Reserve is a huge extension of protected mountains in the Siberia area in Extremadura, declared Biosphere Reserve by Unesco.

Explore it and contemplate herds of roebucks, bucks, mouflons and deer. In the mating season (from the end of summer to the beginning of autumn), the male animals barely eat, and you can hear their impressive and deep roar to call their female partners and mark their territory.

This is called the 'bellowing', and it is astonishing animal ritual. At night, herds of male and female animals walk around the area in a competition with one another.

The size of these mountains draws the visitors apart from their world and let them feel freedom and a full connection with nature.
